

SY 26/27 Scheduling Timeline for Rising Seniors (Class of 2027) – December 1, 2025 - March 16, 2026

Scheduling for next school year is underway and here is the scheduling timeline for rising seniors:

December 1- 12, 2025

- **IB Diploma Programme (IB DP):** rising IB Diploma Programme (IB DP) seniors completed SY 26/27 Course Registration Form in their IB Theory of Knowledge (TOK) class during the week of **December 1-December 5**.

With IB DP, students follow a set prescribed curriculum for two years. They must complete 3 HL and 3 SL classes, IB TOK, and select one elective course. In addition to IB requirements, students must meet APS graduation requirements and may opt to take a required course online (i.e., Physics, Economics, PE/Pers. Fit., etc.) to have flexibility in their senior schedule.

In the Academic Planner, parents and students can view updated course selections. The Google Forms for Summer AVA courses and Minimum Day (a reduced schedule) will be available in mid-April.

- **IB Career-related Programme (IB CP):** rising IB Career-related Programme (IB CP) seniors completed SY 26/27 Course Registration Form in their IB Pre-Professional Skills (PPS) class during the week of **December 8- December 12**.

With IB CP, students must complete the following requirements over a two-year period: **1) study two IB courses/subjects, 2) complete their pathway (CTAE, FA, or JROTC) course(s), 3) PPS, and 4) Language**. Additionally, IB CP students who currently are in level 3 of a **CTAE course, MUST participate in Work-Based Learning (WBL)**.

IB CP, students have more flexibility to take additional courses in their schedules. In the Academic Planner, parents and students can view updated course selections.

December 5 – February 13, 2026

- **Dual Enrollment (DE) Academic Advisement Conferences**

Rising seniors interested in Dual Enrollment (full-time or part-time) for next school year must do the following:

Students must meet 1-on-1 with grade level counselor to discuss DE academic fit, eligibility and alignment with post-secondary plan and plan tentative DE courses and in-school courses. ***IB DP and IB CP students can only participate in DE during summer term or before the school day during Fall Term (i.e., GT Distant-Math or Computer Science).***

Students will be given the following:

- Academic Advisement Conference form
- Dual Enrollment Schedule Planner
- Dual Enrollment Letter of Intent

Other DE Programs:

Atlanta College Career Academy (ACCA) will be on campus on **March 10th** from 9:30 AM – 3:00 PM to discuss Dual Enrollment Recruitment. ACCA Dual Enrollment deadline is March 15, 2026.

- **IB Course Candidates/College Prep Students:** Mrs. Boykin will be meeting with rising seniors either individually or in small groups to complete course selection for next school year.
