#### What is the PSAT?

A practice version of the SAT exam that covers the same knowledge and skills as the Official SAT

#### **PSAT**


- Practice SAT taken by students in both 10th and
   11th grade
  - PSAT 10: 10<sup>th</sup> Grade
  - PSAT/NMSQT: 11<sup>th</sup> Grade
- Offered in October and can only be taken once per year
- Taken during the school day at NAHS
- Length: 2 Hour 45 Minute Test (139 questions)
- Score ranges from 320 to 1520

#### Official SAT

- College entrance exam taken by students entering the application process for admissions to colleges/universities
- Offered throughout the year and there is no limit on how many times it is taken
- Taken on Saturdays at designated SAT testing sites
- Length: 3 Hours (154 questions)
- Score ranges from 400 to 1600

# What is considered a good PSAT score?

#### PSAT/NMSQT Connection to SAT Success



#### **Content and Domain Alignment**

All tests in the SAT Suite of Assessments (SAT, PSAT/NMSQT, PSAT 10, and PSAT 8/9) are aligned to the same research backbone and focus on the same domain of knowledge and skills.

#### Scoring

All tests in the SAT Suite of Assessments are on a common score scale that provides consistent feedback, enabling teachers to adjust instruction to better support students who are ahead or behind.

- The average PSAT/NMSQT score is about 920.
- A score between 1210 and 1520 puts you in the top 10% of test takers.
- For most students, the PSAT scores have no direct impact on their college admissions process.
- Colleges never receive students' PSAT scores.
- The PSAT was written to pair with the SAT; although the SAT is longer and more difficult, PSAT scores give a general sense of a student's potential SAT score

The test covers the same knowledge and skills as the Official SAT



NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

#### National Merit® Scholarship Program



An annual academic competition among high school students for recognition and college scholarships.



Is conducted by National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC®)



The 2022 PSAT/NMSQT® is the qualifying test for entry to the 2024 National Merit Program.



Competition lasts from entry in Fall of 2022 thru Spring of 2024 when scholarships for college undergraduate study will be awarded


#### National Merit Scholarship Competition 2024

- Includes HS juniors planning to enter college in the Fall of 2024
- Students are entered into the National Merit Scholarship Program by taking the PSAT/NMSQT
- <u>PSAT/NMSQT</u> serves as an initial screening of over 1.5 million entrants each year
- NMSC® uses PSAT/NMSQT Selection Index scores to determine 50,000 highscoring participants who qualify for program recognition and may proceed to the next phase of the competition.

#### **PSAT REPORT MAIN PAGE: SCORE OVERVIEW**



#### Test scores and subscores

Red, yellow, and green ranges reflect areas of strengths and weaknesses compared to the typical performance of students.



#### Section scores

Need to Strengthen Skills = below grade-level benchmark by more than one year

Approaching Benchmark = below grade-level benchmark by one year or less

Meets or Exceeds Benchmark = at or above grade-level benchmark


### TEST SCORES & BENCHMARKS

All scores are reported in performance zones that indicate whether students are on track for meeting the college readiness benchmarks on the SAT



#### UNDERSTANDING PERCENTILES





#### Percentile Rank:

- a number between 1 and 99 that shows how your student scored compared to other students
- It represents the percentage of students whose scores fall at or below your student's score.

#### **Nationally Representative Sample Percentile:**


• compares your student's score to typical scores of other U.S. students in his/her grade.


#### **User Percentile:**

## CollegeBoard sent students an email with their unique Access Code (Dec 5th - 6th )


Go to the inbox for the email address your student provided on his/her PSAT answer sheet in October. Run a search for "Collegeboard" or "PSAT" if needed.

#### Reasons a Student May Not Have Received an Email from CollegeBoard:

- Did not provide an email address on their PSAT answer sheet
- The email provided was incorrect, not a valid email or was not legible

## IF YOUR STUDENT DOES NOT HAVE THE COLLEGEBOARD EMAIL, GO TO: STUDENTSCORES.COLLEGEBOARD.ORG

- Ask your student first if he/she has already set up a Collegeboard account



If you took a test in the 2021-22 school year, check whether your scores have been released:


- · SAT score release schedule

- For PSAT-related a sessments, you may have to update information. Go to the Matching Tool to verify. To may 'Update My Info'. It you have an Access Code, click 'Get'.
- 2. For SAT, contact Custo. or Service of AT Support or 866-7.6-7346.



# CREATE A TEST PREP PLAN WITH YOUR STUDENT



#### **Setting a Plan for Success**

- Research college freshman class profiles to find the range of test scores needed to be competitive in the application process
- Review PSAT score reports w/student
- Map out a timeline for when student will plan to take the official SAT/ACT
- Decide which test prep strategies are the best fit for your student
- Discuss with your student what can help keep him/her motivated to follow thru on their test prep plan?
- Register for official tests via the Collegeboard and ACT websites (registration deadlines are approx. 1 month prior to test date)
- Look for practice test opportunities that are close to your official test dates (and register for those tests)



### TEST ACCOMMODATIONS FOR COLLEGEBOARD AND ACT TESTS

Students w/testing accommodations do not automatically receive those accommodations on any of the following tests:

COLLEGEBOARD: SAT, PSAT, and All AP Exams ACT:
ACT and Pre-ACT

- CollegeBoard & ACT are two DIFFERENT entities, and each has its own process for reviewing documentation to approve or deny accommodations requests.
- Review process can take 7 weeks or longer
- If your child has approval for standardized accommodations at the school-level through a 504 or IEP, you may request to have those same accommodations for standardized tests with CollegeBoard and/or ACT.
