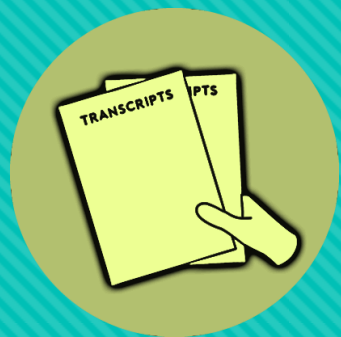

- Students have been placed in the highest level courses they qualify for based on Rising 10th Grade Placement Guidelines.
- If you **WERE NOT PLACED in an Honors or AP level class**, then your grades and/or tests scores did not meet the requirements for the class and **ARE NOT ELIGIBLE** for those classes.
- If you **were placed in an Honors or AP level class** and **want to go down a level**, you may request a change during the Add/Drop period in March

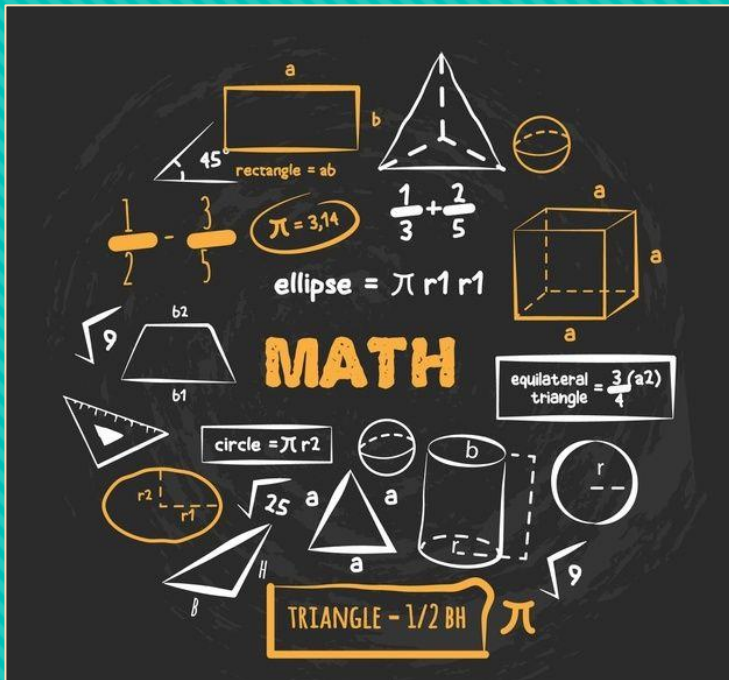

Chemistry Class Comparison



Pre-AP Chemistry:

- Students must OPT IN to the course (Course Request form or Add/Drop Form)
- Encouraged for students with 90+ average in regular Math and Biology and Lexile score of 1100+

Regular Chemistry

- Grade-level expectations
- Work towards mastery of Georgia Standards
- Completion of science fair presentation

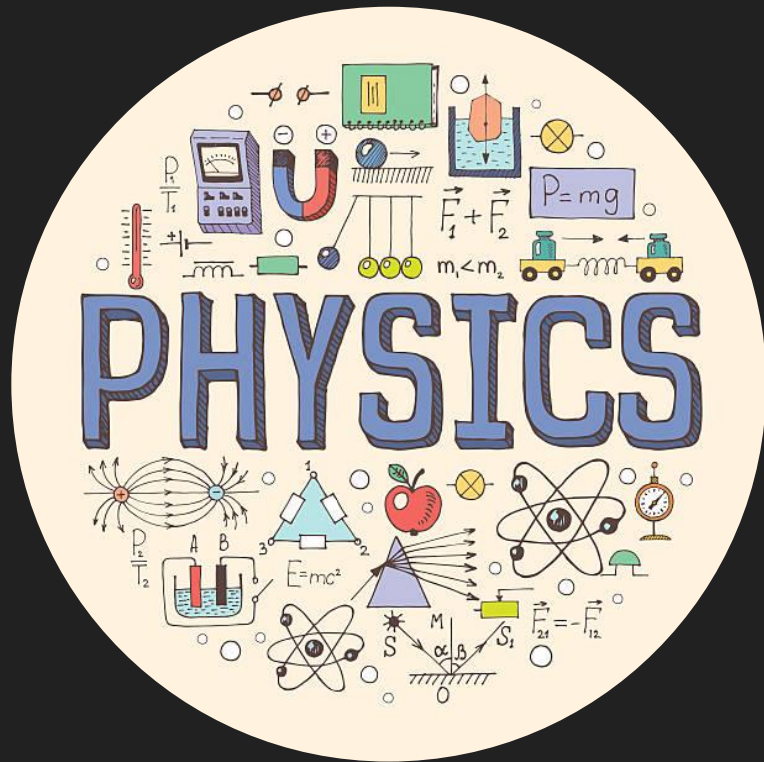
Honors Chemistry

- Advances beyond the regular class level of standards
- Requires completion of Science Fair project and presentation)
- Required to complete one project per unit
- Required to complete one case study per week
- Assessments will include 5-10 open response questions on assessments

Pre-AP Chemistry

- College Board content/skills emphasized in addition to Georgia Standards
- Approved by College Board
- More focus on preparing you for future college classes
- Pre-AP provides a framework for the course
- Moves at a quicker pace
- Covers topics in greater depth
- Requires completion of Science Fair project and presentation)
- Some assignments will be completed under My AP
- Each unit contains: In-Lesson formatives, 2 learning checkpoints and 1 performance task

AP Physics Pre-Requisites

- Lexile score of 1200+
- 85+ average in Honors Biology, Honors Chemistry and Honors Algebra 2 **OR** 90+ average in Biology, Chemistry and Algebra 2
- Completion of Honors or Regular Chemistry over the summer OR submission of Chemistry course waiver
 - ♦ **Students are highly discouraged from waiving Chemistry due to some colleges requiring it for admissions.**

Taking AP Physics in 10th Grade

- Students **cannot** take double science in 10th grade
- 10th Grade Placement into AP Physics course will be based on seat availability (11th graders get priority)
- On-Level and Honors level Physics classes are not open to 10th graders.
- Students must request AP Physics using the Add/Drop Google Form in March

- All course request changes must be submitted using the Add/Drop Google form which will be open from March 18-20
- Students/Parents can access the Add/Drop form using the link or QR code provided below.
- Schedule change requests sent via email WILL NOT be processed; counselors will only [review](#) and process requests submitted on the Add/Drop form.
- Students/Parents will not receive status updates or notifications about requested changes; approved changes will be viewable in the Infinite Campus Academic Planner after spring break.
- No class changes for the 2024-25 school year will be accepted after the form closes on March 20, 2024.
